

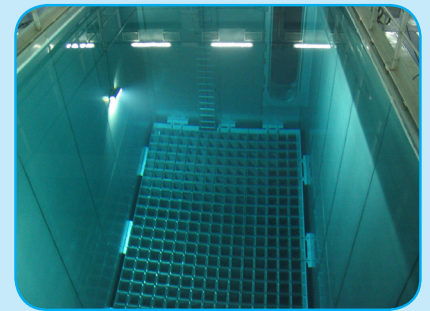
## New rules, new regulations

Following the entry into force of the new laws on the physical protection of nuclear sites, new security clearance requirements now apply.

As of July 1, 2013, security clearance will be mandatory in order to access the technical perimeter. To access the entire site, SECRET clearance level will be required.

### How to obtain your clearance or security certificates :

Requests must be submitted by your company's security officer to the ANS, i.e. the Autorité Nationale de Sécurité (Belgian National Security Authority). If you do not have a security officer, contact the ANS to obtain clearance for your company and communicate the name of a security officer: Rue des Petits Carmes 15, 1000 Brussels. Tel.: 02 501 81 11.



For external companies with fewer than 10 staff members that do not have a security officer, Electrabel can enter a security certificate request and carry out the security clearance requests.

The security certificate is valid for one year and may only be requested every 4 years.  
We advise you to request your SECRET level clearance at the same time.
